



Stone Building Company Hosts Celebration for UAB's The Marshall

STONE BUILDING COMPANY held a Topping Out Ceremony for The Marshall project, an off-campus luxury student housing community for the University of Alabama at Birmingham, on Friday, October 8. The ceremony commemorates the project's continued progress with the placement of the last truss at the top of the seven-story structure.



"The Topping Out Ceremony celebrates a key milestone in a construction project when the structure phase of the work is complete," said Justin Drummond, president at Stone Building Company. "Today we recognize all of the hard work from our project team that has taken place over the last year to hit our schedule milestone."

As part of the ceremony, subcontractors, representatives from Stone, and more than 150 trade workers on the project signed the final truss before it was hoisted to the top and installed in place. The 300,000-square-foot building is scheduled to be completed for students in the summer of 2022.

The project, located on Third Avenue South in Birmingham's Parkside District will include views of UAB and downtown Birmingham and will provide 409 student residences and 10,000 square feet of amenity space including a pool, game room, study rooms, fitness, technology center and outdoor gathering spaces.
